

Safari I Have, Who Has



1. You will need the Safari I Have, Who Has sheet.
2. Cut the I Have, Who Has sheet apart.
3. Each student in the room should have a letter card or share a card with a partner.
4. An adult or older student should assist the child in reading their card beginning with the card, "I have the first card."
5. From here, each student should look at their picture and the letter that goes with it in order to find the next letter.
6. If the child has the right letter and picture, he or she should read their card out loud with the assistance of an adult.
7. For example, I have m, Who has o? I have o, who has w?
8. When students have mastered letter identification, the game can be played using letter sounds.
