## **GO STOP BOARD**

- 1. Use your Go, Stop Board to emphasize directionality of sight words.
- 2. Use your kindergarten Sight Word Sheet to select a sight word.
- 3. It is recommended that you use magnetic letters or cut out letters for this activity.



- 4. It is recommended that you laminate your Go, Stop Board for durability.
- 5. An adult or older child should locate necessary letters to spell the sight word and then mix them up.
- 6. The child will now attempt to place the letters in correct sequence on the road map.
- 7. Push the letters together going from left to right to correctly spell the sight word
