RHYME CONCENTRATION

- 1. Print Rhyno Rhyme playing cards and cut them apart.
- Select two rhyming cards for each rhyme set (some have 3).
- 3. Select the number of match cards you want to begin the game with (recommended: 6 matches).
- 4. Turn the cards upside down in rows to prepare to play.
- 5. Take turns flipping two cards per turn to attempt a rhyme match.
- 6. If a player finds a match, they keep the pair on their side.
- 7. If there is no match, turn the cards back to starting position.
- 8. The game is over when all matches have been discovered.
- 9. The winner of the game is the player that has the most rhyme matches.
