## SAFARI ANIMAL CLUES

- 1. You will need the Safari Animal Clues document.
- 2. Practice reading from left to right, while pointing at each word as you read the sentence.
- 3. Have students guess the animal before moving on to the next sentence.
- 4. After the student has guessed the animal, return to the first sentence and read all of the sentences together again.
- 5. During the second read, students can locate familiar sight words, count words in a sentence, or locate letters they know.
- 6. The emphasis of this activity is sight word repetition.
- 7. The repetitive reading found in this activity is essential to building reading skills.
