

SAFARI LETTER CATEGORY SORT

1. Introduce the Safari Letter Categories using the handout.
2. It is recommended that you have magnetic letters or letter cut outs to use as manipulatives.
3. Use the Two Way Sort Board for this activity.
4. Place a stick and hook letter example at the top of the Two Way Sort (eg. Place a “t” for the stick letter and a “j” for the hook letter).
5. Place the remaining letters in a pile and allow the student to sort hook and stick letters.
6. Continue this game until all letter categories have been practiced.
