

# SAFARI MIXED UP ALPHABET

1. You will need two copies of the Mixed-Up Safari Alphabet Chart.
2. Cut one chart apart and make a pile containing the full alphabet.
3. The child will flip one letter card over and try to find a match on the Mixed-Up Alphabet Chart.
4. After making a match, the child will say the letter name and the animal associated with it.
5. After learning all the letter names, the child will make a match and say the sound associated with the letter.
