SAFARI NAME WRITING

- 1. Each child should receive a large sheet of paper such as 11 x17.
- 2. The child's name should be written ahead of time with an Upper Case letter followed by all Lower Case letters.
- 3. Practice naming each letter in their name and then tracing the letters several times.
- 4. Letter formation should be discussed as students trace the letters.
- 5. It is recommended that you have magnetic letters or letter cut outs to use as manipulatives.
- 6. After writing their name several times and creating a rainbow, students should use the magnetic letters to create their name.
