1. You will need the Safari Sight Words for Sentences and Safari Sight Word Sentence Pictures.
2. After cutting the documents apart, choose Sight Words and pictures to create short sentences.
3. For example, "I see the lion."
4. Practice reading the created sentences together.
5. The emphasis of this activity is sight word repetition and fostering the understanding of reading right to left.
6. The repetitive reading found in this activity is essential to building reading skills.
