

# SAFARI SOUND SORT



1. You will need the Safari Sound Sort Board and the Safari Letter Word Sort pictures.
2. An adult or older student will choose two pictures to place at the top of the Safari Sound Sort Board.
3. An adult or older student will select six random pictures including six pictures that match the beginning sounds of the two, which have been placed at the top of the game board.
4. An adult or older student will place pictures on a pile and flip and say one picture at a time.
5. Students will decide if the picture matches the beginning sound of either picture at the top of the game board.
6. The game is over after students have sorted through and classified matching cards on the game board.
