- 1. You will need the Sight Word list.
- 2. Using the Safari Word Box document, place a sight word in each box (document lamination recommended for dry erase markers and repeated use).
- 3. Create a Safari Word Wand using a pipe cleaner and curling ribbon.
- 4. Practice pointing and reading each sight word.
- 5. The adult or older child can call out sight words, letters, or letter sounds for the student to locate within the word boxes.
