

# SAFARI WORD BOX POSTER

1. You will need the Sight Word list.
2. Using the Safari Word Box document, place a sight word in each box (document lamination recommended for dry erase markers and repeated use).
3. Create a Safari Word Wand using a pipe cleaner and curling ribbon.
4. Practice pointing and reading each sight word.
5. The adult or older child can call out sight words, letters, or letter sounds for the student to locate within the word boxes.
