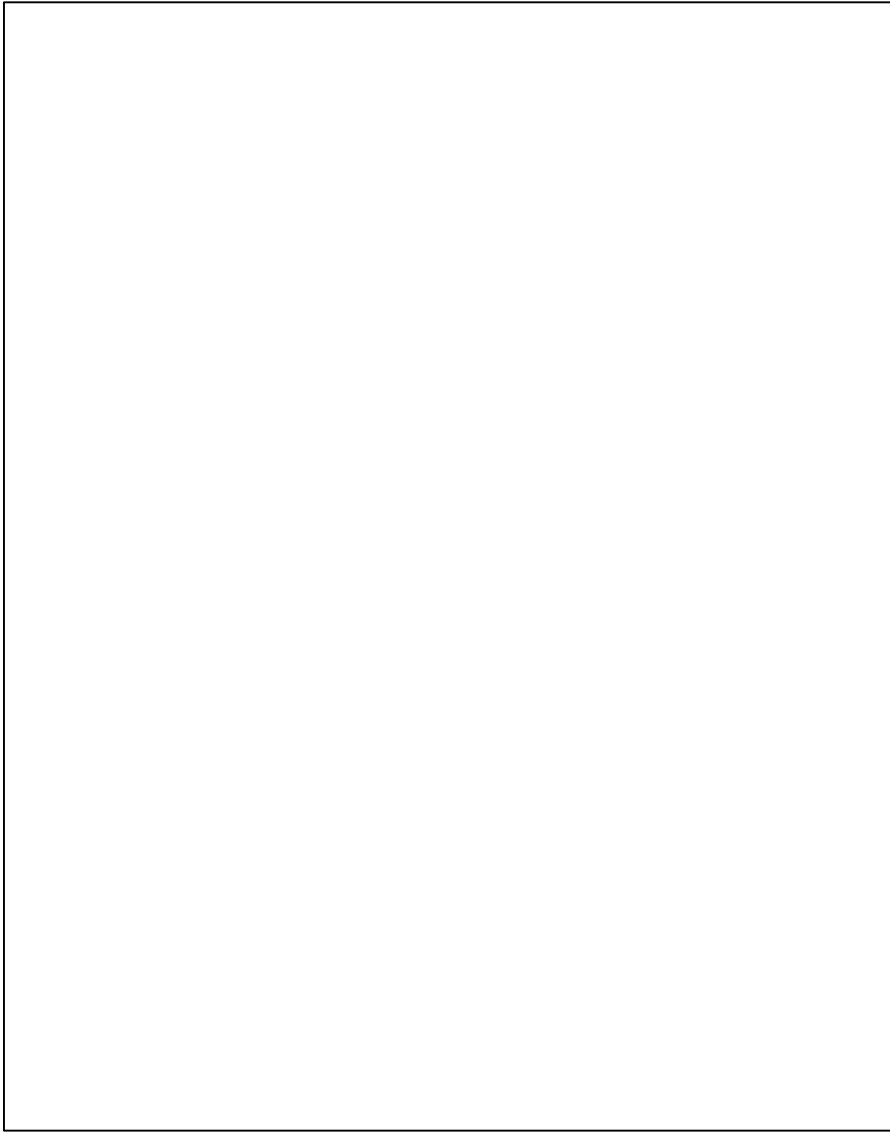

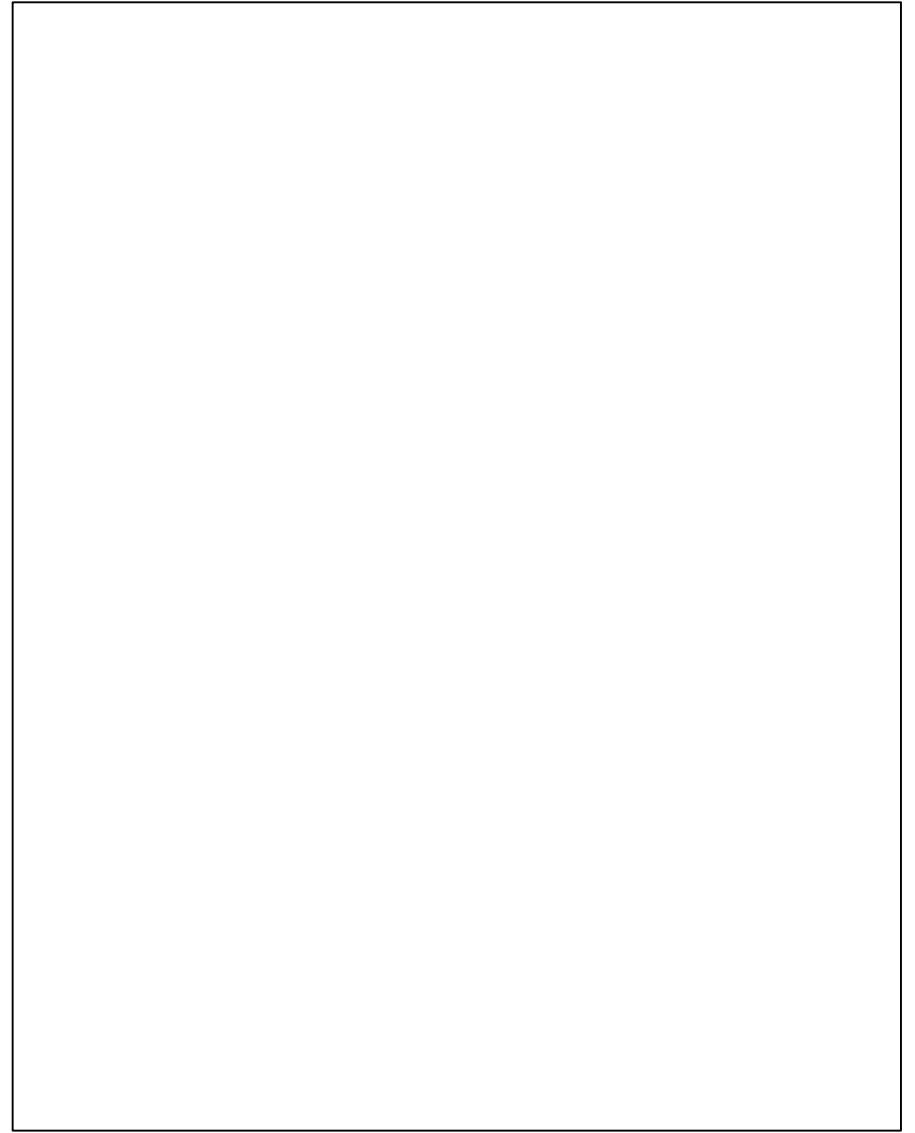
Feathers grow on the wings of baby Xander.



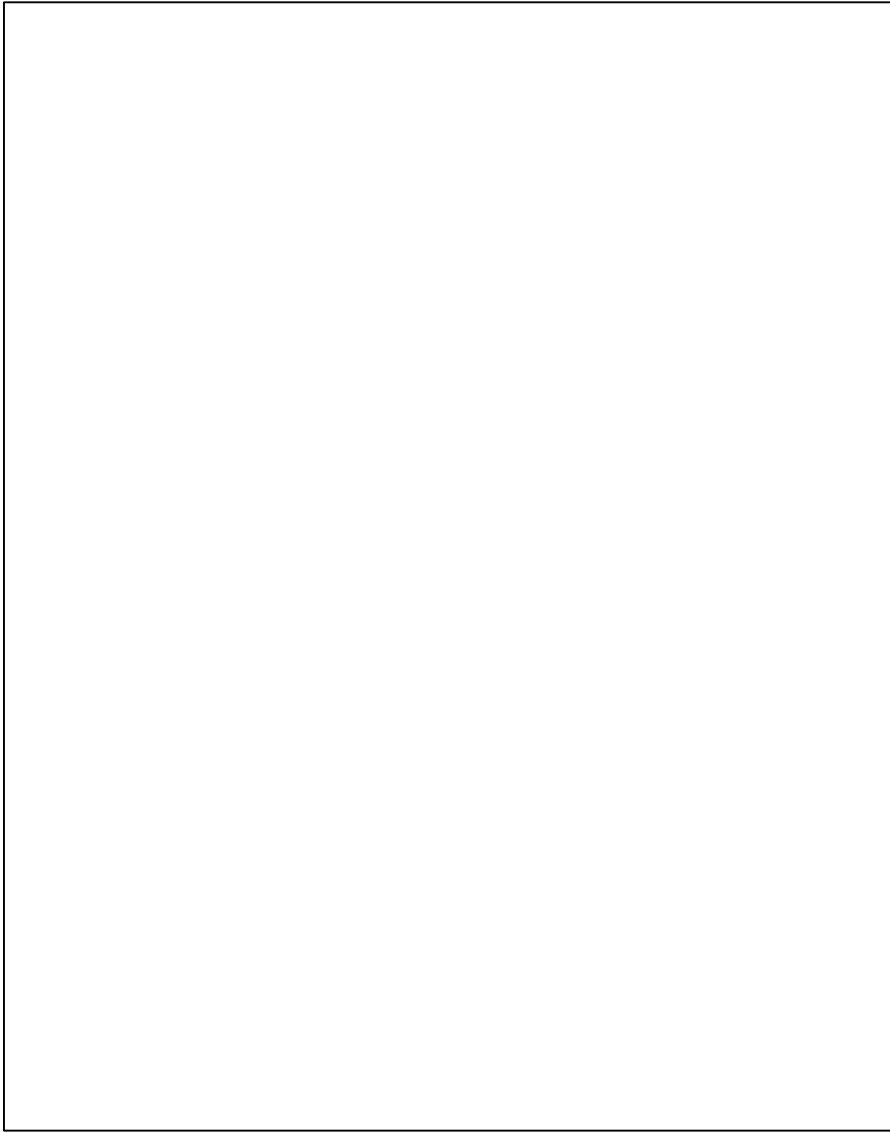
Baby birds hatch from eggs.



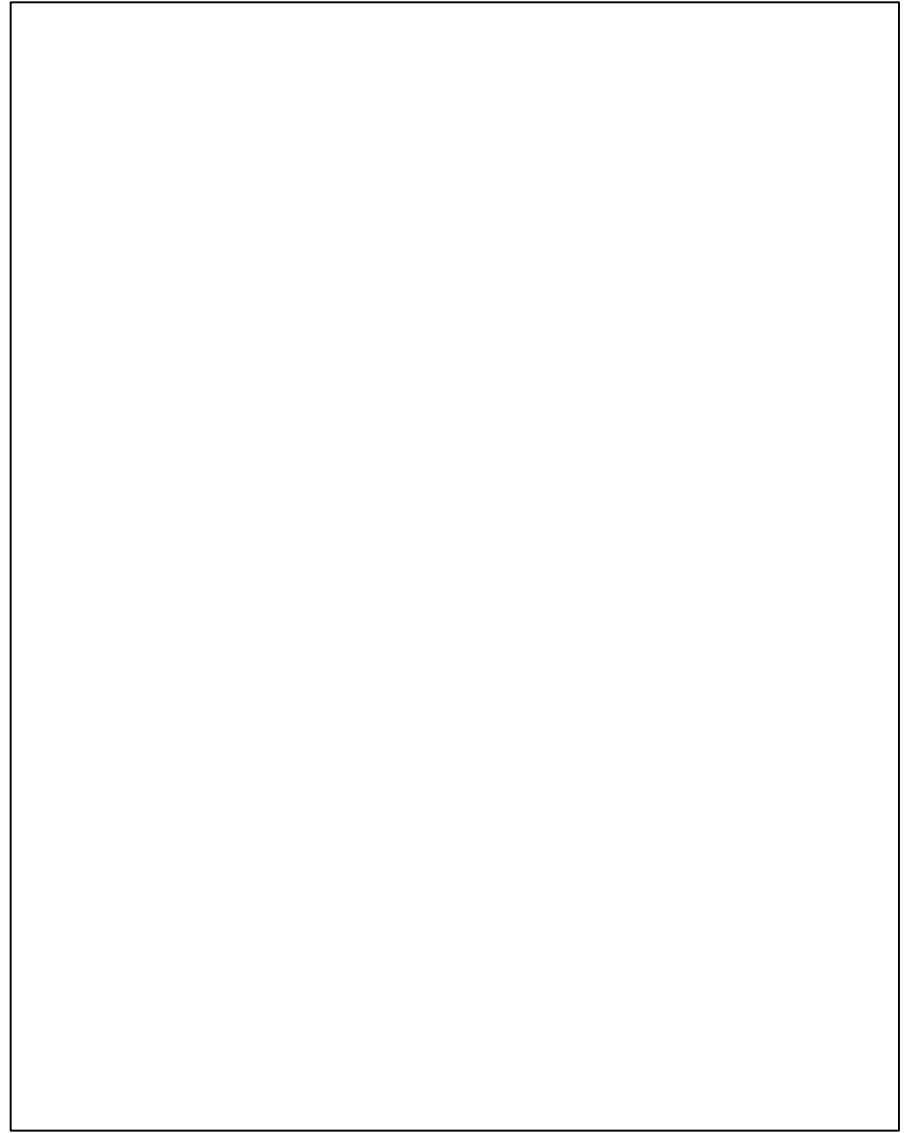
Baby Xander has no feathers.

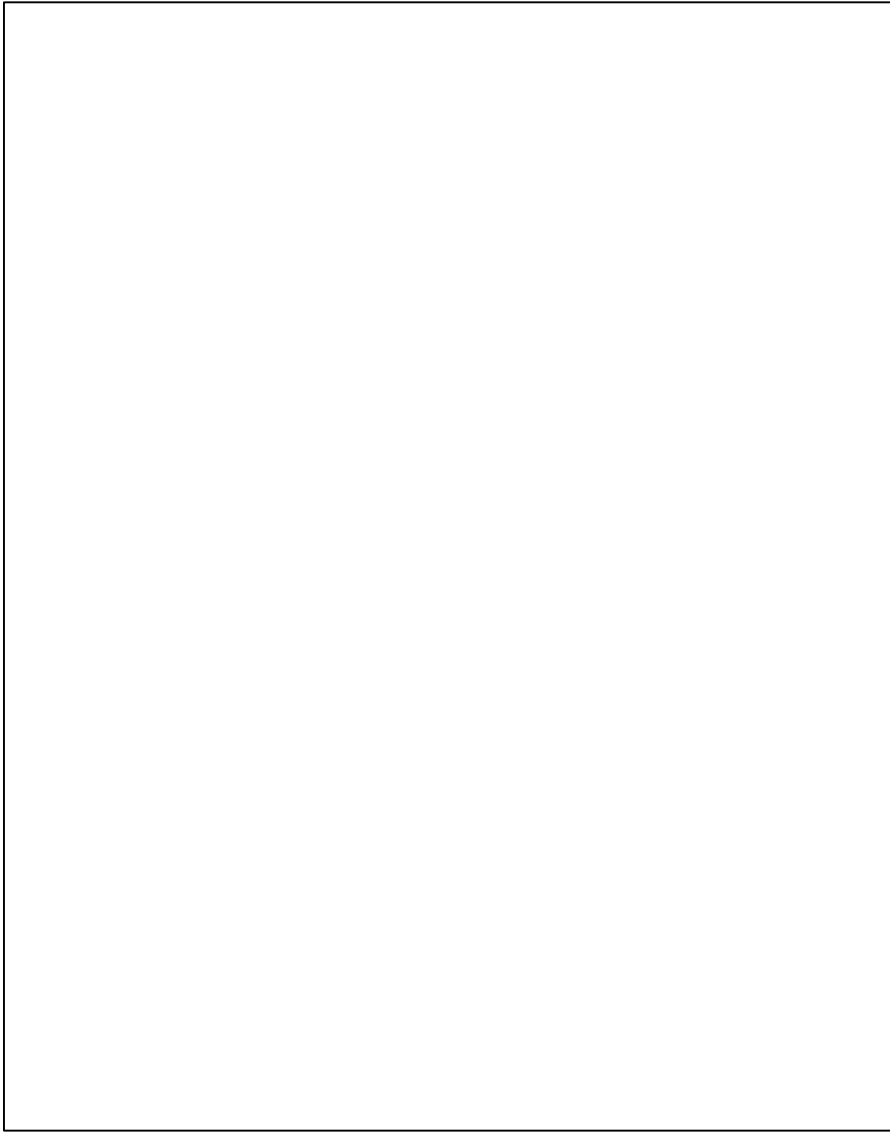


Feathers grow on the body of baby Xander.
