PHOTOSHOP PICTURES

- 1. Print selected photo shop pictures.
- 2. Provide each family with a photo shop picture.
- 3. Tell student to look at the picture and orally tell you what they think is happening in the photo.
- 4. If this is a problem for the student, they should compose the story or sentence together.
- 5. After orally composing the story together, it is suggested that families continue to ask what would happen next.
- 6. It is then recommended that families continue this at home with family photos or pictures found in newspapers or magazines.
