

SHAPE SENTENCE COUNTERS

1. Supply each student with several different shapes.
2. Lay out four shapes in a row on the floor.
3. Practice the understanding of space between words in a sentence by walking on each shape while calling out its name.
4. Reinforce one-to-one match by creating a four word sentence.
5. For example, "The dog is fast." Model walking a different shape for each word and stepping over the space between each shape.
6. This reinforces the skill of word spacing relationships as well as shape names.
7. Extension: What shape is behind you? What shape is next to/in front of you?
