

TEN VICIOUS VIPERS



1. Begin by cutting the Vipers and placing them on a pile.
2. Read each book page together. Determine the correct number of vipers to be glued on the page. If glue is not available, you can lay the vipers on the page and remove them for use on the next page.
3. Practice counting the vipers using one-to-one pointing.
4. Reread the page after you have placed and counted the vipers.
5. Extension: Compare number of vipers on various pages.

COMMON CORE CONNECTION
